Allow us to begin with some remembrance that may lead us to the future!

L. Kolisko

and the Foundation Stone Conference at Christmas 1923

All of us who love anthroposophy are fully aware of the cardinal importance of this event. We are all engaged in celebrating in a dignified fashion its 100th year anniversary where R. Steiner wanted to renew the esoteric impulse underlying our movement and thus building again a foundation to a community striving.

What is perhaps less well known is that on each one of the seven days following the Foundation

Day (12.24) R. Steiner gave not only an all-important esoteric meditative rhythm (which he said "should never leave us again") but included in that day specific presentations that were meant to show how the spiritual impulses would be connected to practical life.

On the 31st of December 1923, in the middle of this crucial conference, he asked L. Kolisko (10.1.1889-11.20.1976) to give the results of her experiments showing that the "influence of the smallest entities" (ultradiluted potencies) could be shown in wave like forms.



The words that R. Steiner accompanied her presentation with were clearly meant not just for then but also pointers to the future. He remarked that her all important work was possible only through her personal sacrifice, an unending personal sacrifice. However, it was essential because anthroposophy needed to penetrate science in a new way. And then he surprisingly remarked that would donations of 50 to 75 million Swiss Francs (probably astonishingly more in todays money) be made available, then the work needed to be done in seventy-five years could be accomplished in five to ten years. Clearly, even then (and in his presence) raising funds for the sciences was not an easy task.

On that day -when her experiments were presented- R. Steiner ended with the rhythm:

Godly-Light

Christ - Light

That the elemental beings hear

From

East, West, North and South

May human beings hear it.

Following R. Steiner's advice Lily Kolisko worked with thousands of wheat seeds and discovered rhythms that had not been known before. Since the Archai Michael has chosen the world of rhythms to make his home, the importance of this work becomes ever more evident. Considering her breakthrough results one can also intuit that the elemental beings heard her.

Our Research Work

We are proud to continue in her direction and have chosen to concentrate on the work with cell cultures. Experiments with cell cultures, statistical calculations and advanced technical details should bring her strivings into the modern scientific community.

After literally many years of careful studies (demanding a lot of resources) we have succeeded to begin presenting our data such that it is acceptable to the general scientific community.

Below three such examples-that are developed far enough that they deserve to be brought to your attention:

 Pilot Study: New Aqueous Extracts of the Mistletoe (Viscum Album L.) Plant, Diminish In Vitro Cell Proliferation of The NSCLC Cell Line with EGFR Mutations HCC 827 Abstract

Non-small cell lung adenocarcinoma with EGFR mutations continues to be a vexing problem due to the ability of the cancer to rapidly develop drug resistance. In vitro studies with the non-small cell lung adenocarcinoma cell line HCC827 (with an acquired mutation in the EGFR tyrosine kinase domain, E746 - A750 deletion) are relevant to the finding of increasingly effective treatments. Pharmaceutically processed, extracts of mistletoe, Viscum album Loranthaceae, have been shown

since the 1920's to have potential in cancer therapy. They are currently the most frequently used natural preparations in complementary cancer treatments. In this pilot study we demonstrate that newly prepared standardized extractions of mistletoe (Viscum album, L.), from different host trees, are shown to significantly diminish the cell proliferation of the HCC 827 cell line.

2. Therapeutic applications of Viscum Robinia RK 30X

Abstract

The spiritual significance of the robinia tree and the mistletoe (Viscum album L.) growing on the robinia tree can be better understood if the anthroposophic interpretation supported by botany, mythology and other healing systems is considered. Viscum Robinia (RK) in its potentized form, dispensed orally, has been found helpful to strengthen the soul life of those patients who have lost faith in the possibility of healing, are overcome by worries, cannot let go of previous trauma, feel unable to go on and to persevere in spite of life's challenges. This soul condition is frequently connected to digestive disturbances. Five clinical cases are presented.

3. Pilot study: rhythmical behavior of ultra-high potencies of substances in cell cultures Abstract

Research in the hormetic field has demonstrated a bi-phasic dose response in substances such that a high dose of a substance being inhibiting/toxic can have an opposite effect at a low dose where it becomes stimulating. Hormesis confines itself to measurable levels of the substances/stressors. However, homeopathic research has shown that these bi-phasic enantiodromic effects of substances occur even at ultra -high dilutions (potencies), beyond log 24. In 1923 R. Steiner and L. Kolisko demonstrated a new phenomenon in which the

enantiodromic effects alternate semi-sinusoidally between inhibiting and stimulating activities. We have studied this phenomenon in several substances in cell cultures, confirm Kolisko's and R. Steiner's findings and discuss the significance of this rhythmical phenomenon. The mechanistic explanation is still to be elucidated but anthroposophical insights give a path to a more comprehensive understanding.

Our research work specifically with our new extraction method has demonstrated that these mistletoe plants have the ability to lead to the death of cancer cells but also to have highly valuable stimulating effects clinically on the soul life of patients.
